Transport and mobility

The Jutland Corridor is a transport network that connects South Norway, West Sweden and Jutland (DK) with the European Continent. The large daily transport of goods and passengers creates growth and development, but also creates a need for sustainable solutions that ensure a reduction of CO2 and emissions.

To develop efficient and green multimodal transport solutions in the corridor, there is a need to coordinate, harmonise and synchronize planning and investments in infrastructure within all modes and alternative fuels across borders. The Jutland Corridor is a part of the EU's TEN T main corridor network for road and rail, ScanMed . This status must be used to develop the efficiency , sustainability and visibility of the

EXPECTED RESULTS::

- Calculations of the climate footprint of the corridor and its socio economic effects.
- Proposals for and test of new/improved multimodal, cross border transport solutions.
- Action plan to remove bottlenecks in the infrastructure for rail, road, sea and alternative fuels in a cross border perspective.
- Test of solutions/methods for reducing emissions from sea, rail and road transport.
- Draft agreements between Denmark and Norway (possibly Sweden) about upgrading transport infrastructure on road, rail and sea, as well as for alternative fuels.
- Agreements with actors on further dialogue and cooperation, possibly the establishment of a permanent corridor development platform which involves authorities, ports, transport operators and goods owners in the business community.

The project's partnership (26 organizations in total) consists of public and private participants from authorities, ports, transport and energy industry. Dialogue with operators in the environment is crucial for the project. Therefore, emphasis is placed on contact and arrangements with companies, shipping companies, ports, etc. also outside the partner circle.

2. Positioning on possibilities and advantages of the Jutland Corridor.
